#### Music for Me Program (Volunteers Needed!)

We had the pleasure of having Veronica Ladd – The Education & Support Coordinator along with Kathleen Ingrim – The Operations Manager, both from the Alzheimer's Society. They were here to present us with 3 IPods for the Residents with brilliantly sewed covers/holders for the headphones, charger and the IPod. We are fortunate to have such a wonderful partnership with the Alzheimer's Society.

The Music for Me Program is a remarkable program that provides an IPod, charger and a set of headphones for the Residents. We look at Residents who are experiencing personal expressions and provide them an opportunity to use the IPod to help with these moments. The family and Residents will be contacted to see what kind of music they enjoy most and what would hold the most meaning to them. That music will then be downloaded on the IPod and delivered to the Resident when needed.

Music is one of the last things people who are diagnosed with Alzheimer's and Dementia loose. This program was developed through a strong relationship and partnership with the Alzheimer's Society and was implemented in 2015.

# **Monthly Resident Recipe**



### Ingredients:

- 1 Cup of white sugar
- ¾ Cup of Mazola Corn Oil
- 2 Eggs
- 1 Teaspoon of baking soda dissolved in 1 teaspoon of warm water
- ½ Teaspoon of salt
- 1 Teaspoon of baking powder
- 1 Teaspoon of vanilla extract
- 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Cup of flour
- 1 Cup of chopped walnuts
- 1 Cup of grated carrots

# **Directions:**

- 1. Beat the sugar, oil and eggs together
- 2. Slowly add all other ingredients
- 3. Stir well
- 4. Bake at 375 for 15-20 minutes
