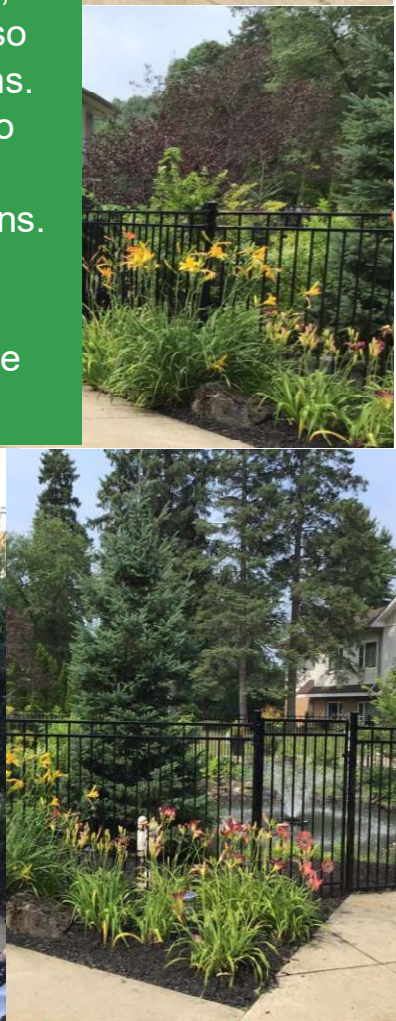
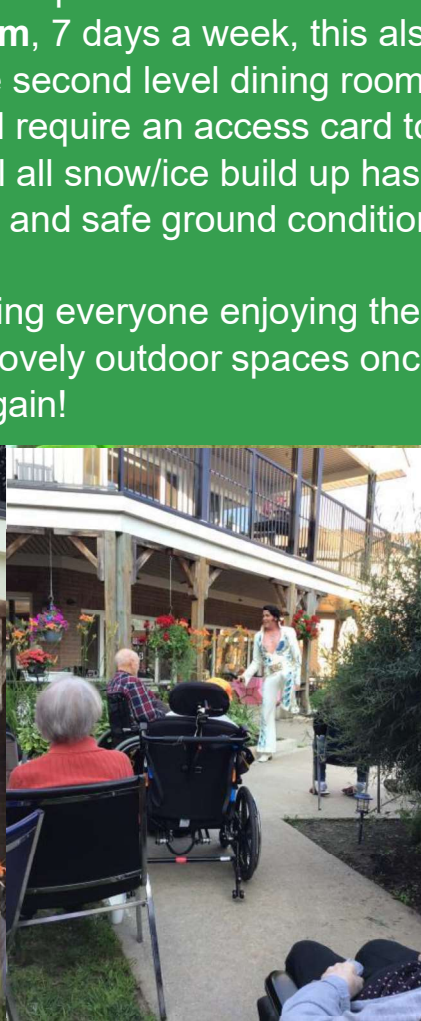


Come visit our outdoor spaces!

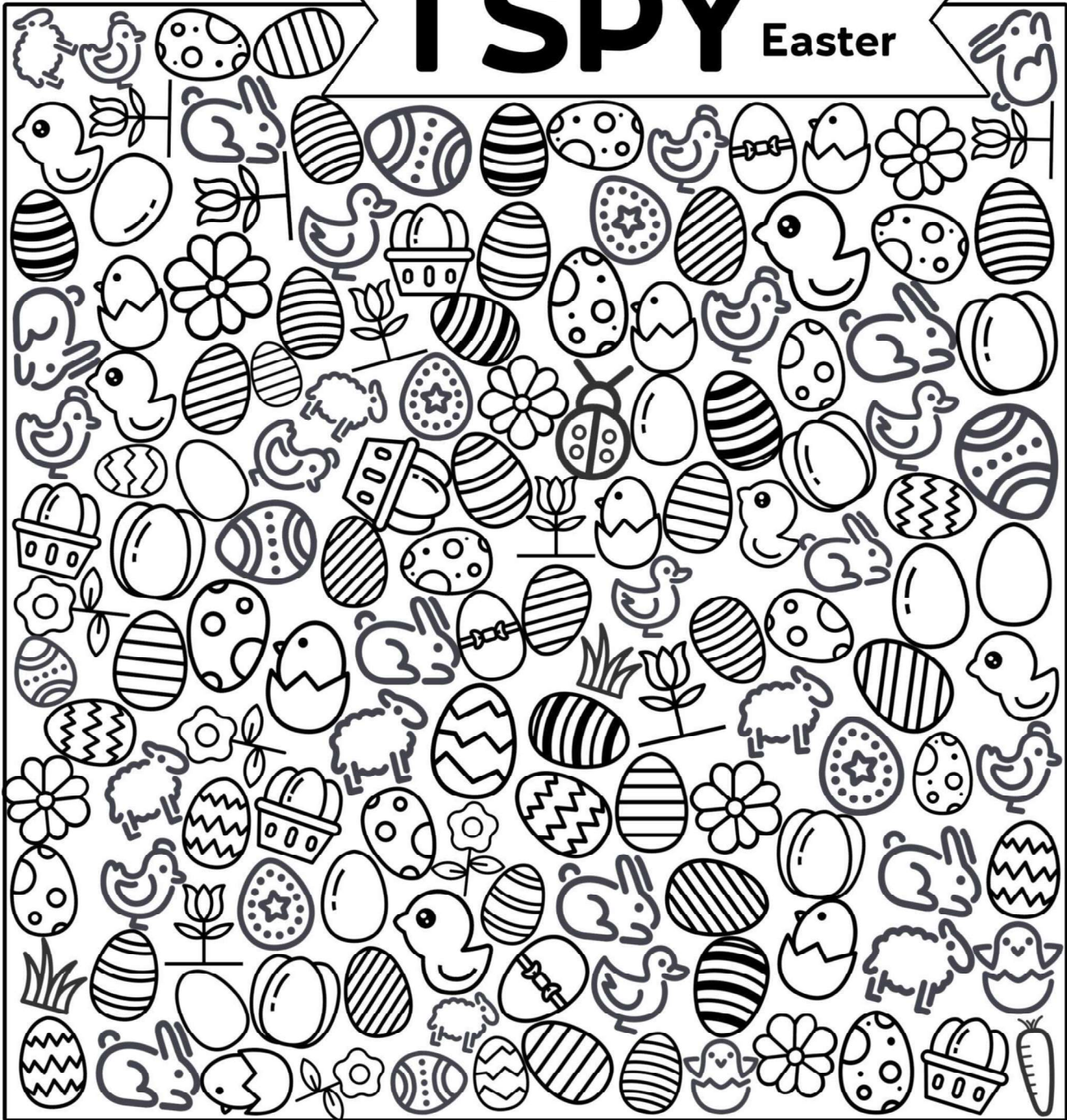
