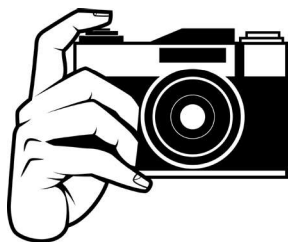


What's happening at Centennial Manor?
