

# The Situation Table was launched in 2015 and falls under the direction of the Hastings County Community Safety and Wellbeing Committee.

A weekly virtual meeting provides opportunity for key organizations to bring forward cases for discussion and determine whether the cases meet AER (Acute Elevated Risk) and require an intervention. The Situation Table does not provide case management.

**29 organizations involved**

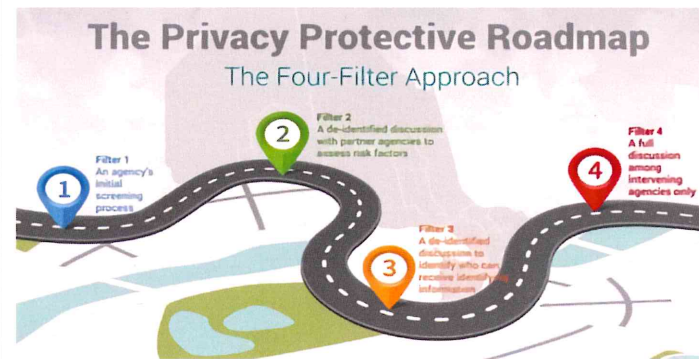

- Filter 1 – Internal screening process
- Filter 2 – De-identified discussion to assess AER
- Filter 3 – De-identified discussion to determine who can appropriately receive information
- Filter 4 – Disclosure among intervening agencies only
