The committee is comprised of the following members from Hastings Centennial Manor (Bancroft) and Hastings Manor (Belleville):

- Administrator
- Director of Nursing
- Infection Control Coordinator
- Quality Coordinator

How often does the committee meet?

- Quarterly

What does the committee do?

- Monitor Quality Improvement Indicators (Falls, Pressure Ulcers, Avoidable Emergency Department visits, Restraints, Depression, Pain, Use of Antipsychotic medication).
- Review trends from abuse and complaints.
- Review Ethical issues that arise in the homes.
- Maintain Accreditation standards.
- Review Ministry of Long-Term Care Inspections.
- Look at current issues in Long-Term care.
- Share learnings.

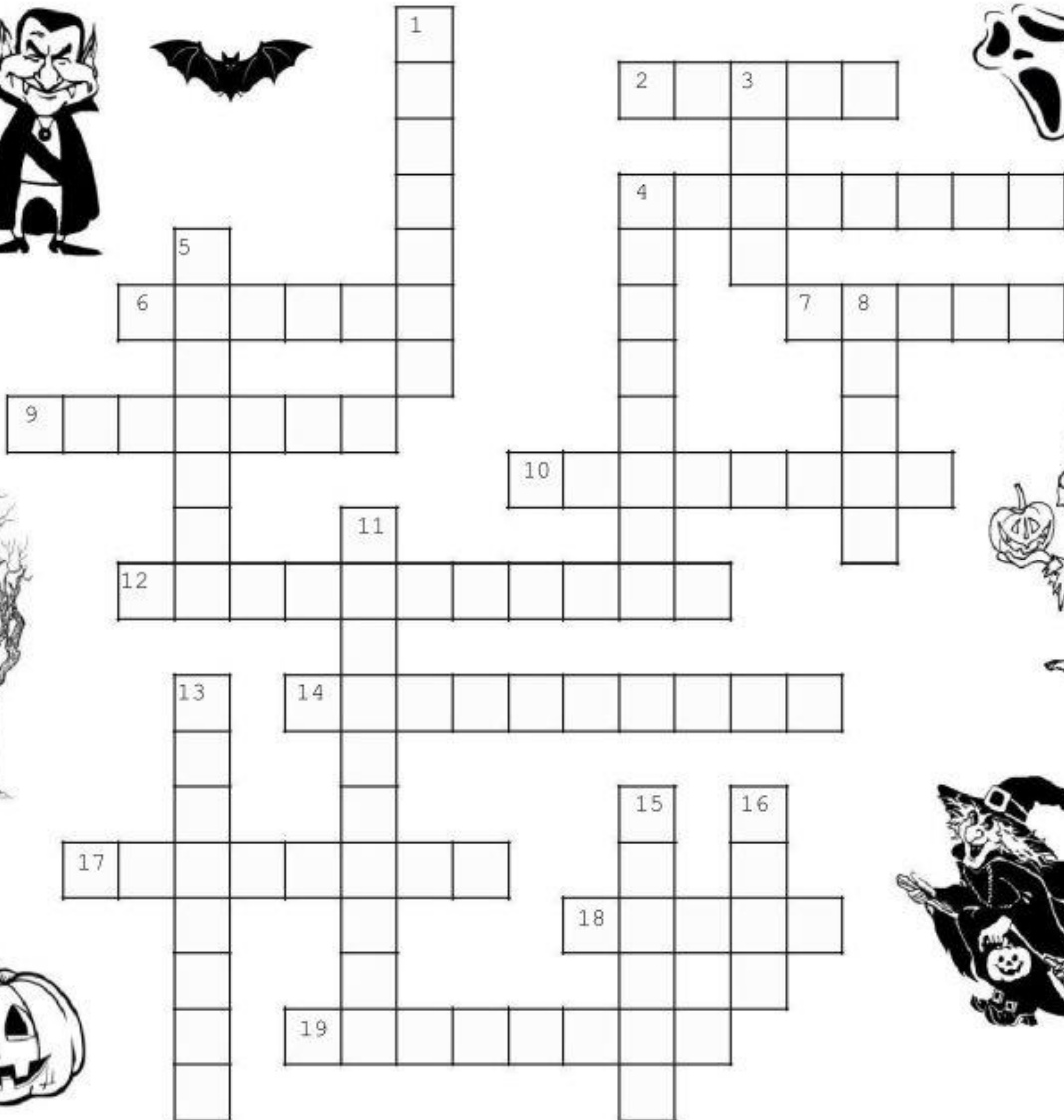
Why do the two homes meet?
